



Protect Your Walls By Facilities

Please, please keep mopping your floors! Word of caution though; be careful not to splash mop water above the cove base in your kitchen and restrooms.

The water can get behind the FRP and cove base and will rot out the wall over time. If the grout has eroded away from between your tiles, the water will also travel under the tiles to the walls and "wick" up the drywall. Over time the wall gets soft, the FRP bubbles, the cove base falls off and it can eventually rot out the studs in the wall.


I.C.E. Kiddie Coaster ride

Beverage Dispenser Lid Modification Instructions

Step 1: Lift beverage dispenser lid.



Step 2: Apply velcro strip to one side of beverage dispenser as shown in picture. Allow velcro strip to dry for approximately 5-10 minutes before opening and closing lid. Repeat process on second dispenser.

NOTE: Only one piece of velcro per dispenser.

Please do not use <u>any</u> type of scrub brush on the awnings! Even a brush wrapped in a towel should not be used as the bristles can come through the towel and shred the protective coating on the awnings.

Use mild liquid soap and water applied with a soft cloth or sponge.

Clean awning from the top down.

DO NOT use a wire brush or one with stiff bristles, or scrub the surface with force.

Rinse thoroughly.

If the awning has deep down dirt on it that will not come off with soap and water, you can use "Simple Green" using a soft cloth.




