NEW SHOW FOR SHOWBIZ

ShowBiz stores will receive a new showtape based on the same theme as the new Chuck E. tape: T.V. Western Theme Songs. This segment will be added to the existing Movie Magic/Rock 'n Roll tape to produce a longer playing show. It is the first time that both systems will be running a tape concurrently which uses the same theme (with the exception of holiday tapes). Our plan is to continue to produce similarly themed shows, when feasible, as it provides us with greater promotional opportunities.

In addition to the new showtape, stores will receive a background music tape featuring other T.V. western theme songs. Participating Family Vision restaurants will have a new Family Vision tape included in their shipment which contains two country/western videos. Also on Family Vision is the all new exciting "Dot Derby", produced especially for ShowBiz. It is a fun game involving a race among dots, which can be enjoyed by the whole family.

All tapes will be shipped prior to March 1, 1987.

NEW SHOW FOR CHUCK E. CHEESE

Prior to March 1, 1987, we will be shipping you a new Chuck E. showtape entitled "T.V. Westerns", featuring theme songs to popular T.V. westerns such as "Rawhide", "Bonanza", and "F-Troop". This segment will be added to the existing Movie Magic/T.V. Themes tape, therefore extending the time in which a show repeats. A springtime special is also included on the new tape.

Along with the tape, you will be receiving new costumes, props, and a backdrop. These will arrive in three separate boxes from the following origins:

NEW SHIPMENT OF POSTERS

The Advertising Fund has paid for a reprint of the 1986 posters. These will be shipped directly to the stores that receive this newsletter. If you have elected for your store not to receive this newsletter, we will ship their posters directly to your office.

JUNE 21, 1987 CO-OP INSERT

It is time to begin planning for the June 21 Co-op Insert. Attached is an order form. To reserve space, your order must be placed with our Marketing Department by March 16, and the payment must be made by April 13. The Company has continued to see sales increase through use of this tool, and we encourage you to take a close look at your locations for possible use. Following are the details, but if you have any questions, call your Franchise Regional Director or the Marketing Department.

ART WORK

The Advertising Committee has funded new art work for the inserts. Copies are not available yet, but the concept is similar to that used in the past. The shot is of a family at a table eating pizza and salad rather than the posed standing shot currently in use. Also, many of you expressed concern about the Coke glass in the last art work. That has been replaced with logoed cups in the new version.

Also, new to this plan is a joint Billy Bob-Chuck E. Cheese piece that many of you have requested for markets where both concepts are located. Be sure to specify which piece you want run in your market.

HOW TO ORDER AND COSTS

Please compute your estimated costs using the attached form. It must be returned by March 16. You will then receive an actual bill. Please note that **DEADLINES MUST BE FOLLOWED.**

1. Media Costs

Attached is a listing of all available market areas. Note that each is assigned a number (1-122). Newspapers in each market, as well as individual newspaper circulation (listed as thousands, 000) are included. Also listed is the total market area circulation.

Media cost is \$6.82 per thousand. You can compute your cost by multiplying \$6.82 by the circulation of your market area. For example:

Market #1 - Full circulation (2 papers)

\$6.82 X 227 = \$1,548.14

However, if you only want the Co-op Insert in one of the market's newspapers, you will pay an additional \$1250 "combo break".
Example:

Market #1 - Portland Telegram ONLY

\$6.82 X 135 -	= \$	920.70
Plus combo break	=	1,250.00
TOTAL		<u>\$2,170.70</u>

In this case, it would cost less to buy the entire market area. We do recommend that you compute costs both ways to determine which is most cost efficient for your market.

2. Production Costs

Production costs average \$600 per market. This includes about \$200 for typesetting addresses, mechanical art production, film and engraving, shipping and tax. Plus, approximately \$400 required by the co-op vendor/printer for black plate changes and strip-ins.

ADDRESSES

Most newspapers allow address/phone listing as shown on the attached copy. Please indicate the appropriate information per market on your order form. We will notify you if your local paper does NOT allow addresses.

SHARED MARKETS

Company markets are noted in the first column of the market listing by the designation SB or CEC. If you are located in a market already designated by the Company, it is possible to "Share", even if your concept varies from the specified concept. Please call Lois Perry to discuss, as Company markets may fluctuate for the June insert.

If you share a market with another franchisee it is possible for you to split the cost of the promotion by including all addresses on the coupon. In these cases, please coordinate with the other franchisee and place one order.

REPEAT ORDERS

If your order is an exact repeat of a previous order, just list as such in the address column on the order form. You will not need to specify addresses again.
